<p>Prewriting: Getting the idea(s) for what you'll be writing about.</p>	<p>Two completed rows of thinking steps in understanding figurative language. (chart)</p>
<p>Drafting: Organizing your ideas into sentences, into paragraphs, into a logical order.</p>	<p>Handwritten or typed sentences.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Topic sentence2. Evidence3. Relevance
<p>Revising: Looking over your writing in order to make improvements, adding, deleting, or rearranging.</p>	<p>Add an appositive in the topic sentence to rename the author. http://www.chompchomp.com/terms/appositive.htm</p> <p>Add an integration style to your evidence.</p> <p>Delete any excess.</p> <p>Avoid starting sentences with coordinating conjunctions (FANBOYS: for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so)</p>
<p>Editing: Making your writing conventionally, grammatically and mechanically correct.
